

History of HYTES

The idea for HYTES began with a trip to Tanzania and Kenya in November 2004 when we met many bright and worldly young people who could not afford school fees. The original six members all felt that scholarships would be an excellent way to make a positive impact on students, their families, and their communities. HYTES started raising money in 2005 and provided 23 scholarships in 2006. That number was more than tripled in 2007 with 78 scholarships.

HYTES now provides scholarships for students in Guatemala, Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda and Zambia.

Why Donate to HYTES?

'Everyone has the right to education' was written into Article 26 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, (Source: www.unesco.org). Even with this 'right', students in many developing countries must pay to attend secondary school and those fees are very often more than families can afford. 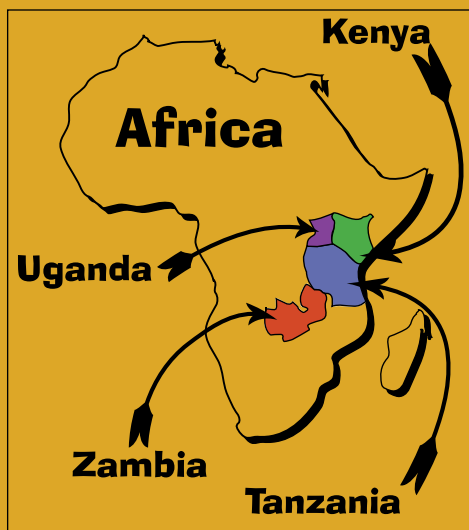
